The Barkerville Heritage Trust is seeking **Casual-on call Security Labourer 1's** to perform security duties; operational duties; and other duties at Barkerville as assigned by the Mgr. Infrastructure, Security & Emergency Preparedness. **Job title: Casual On-Call SECURITY/LABOURER I; BCGEU union position; Salary grade: \$21.11/hr.**

Qualifications, Skills, and Abilities: Requirements needed to perform the job

- Must possess and maintain a valid Security Worker License in British Columbia (Training is available through Barkerville by arrangement.)
- An understanding of heritage conservation principles as defined in the Standards and Guidelines for Conservation of Historic Places
- Ability to safely operate all power and hand tools as well as gas powered equipment
- An understanding of WCB regulations and BHT safety policies and procedures
- A valid Class 5 British Columbia driver's license
- A grade twelve education or a recognized equivalency
- Level 3 First aid certification is an asset and will be provided by the employer. Casuals must gain certification within 2 years of hire for all new employees. At a minimum, Occupational First Aid Level 1 is required and will be provided by the employer.
- Perform all training the Workers Compensation Board deems necessary to fulfill the duties of the position
- Up to date fire prevention and fire suppression training provided by the employer
- Up to date Bear Safety/Wildlife training provided by the employer
- Excellent public relations skills
- A general knowledge of the history of Barkerville Historic Town
- The ability to communicate effectively in both written and oral form
- The ability to perform the duties described within the job description and expectations

Working conditions: physical environment of the job, including on and off site

- May be required to wear an approved uniform or appropriate period costume in the performance of duties
- Occasional travel, at times in adverse weather conditions as necessary
- Required to work outdoors in all weather conditions, including cold, snow and ice
- Required to work safely at a height
- Work will occasionally require the lifting of objects up to 60 pounds
